Action Items All items identified below are for action at the Commission business meeting.

1. T-00.32.OTSC (Wayne)

On March 28, 2000 an Order to Show Cause was issued to Wayne Overhuls, Columbus, Montana, PSC No. 2558, for failure to file required cargo insurance. The Order to Show Cause was sent by certified mail and received by the motor carrier on April 12, 2000. There has been no response from the motor carrier. Staff recommends cancellation.

Class B - Livestock between all points and places in the State of Montana.

SUB B Class C - Houses and buildings of all types and sizes between all points and places in the State of Montana.

SUB D Class B - Property between Columbus, Montana, and Roberts, Montana, via Luther. Limitations: Transportation of ashes, trash, waste, refuse, rubbish and garbage is prohibited.

SUB E Class B - Household goods (as defined by Commission) from Columbus, Montana and Roberts, Montana via Luther to all points and places in the State of Montana and from all points and places in the State of Montana to Columbus, Montana and Roberts, Montana via Luther.

2. T-00.31.OTSC (Wayne)

On March 28, 2000 an Order to Show Cause was send to Terry McIntosh dba Hi-Line Transportation, Havre, Montana, PSC No. 9406, for failure to reactivate following twelve consecutive months of suspension. The Order to Show Cause was sent by certified mail and received by the motor carrier on April 5, 2000. There has been no response from the motor carrier. Staff recommends cancellation.

Class A – Passengers between Havre, Montana and Great Falls, Montana regularly serving the intermediate points of Big Sandy and Fort Benton and with on-call service to Box Elder, Loma and Carter, Montana.

3. T-00.36.RI (Wayne)

On March 30, 2000 Red Lodge Shuttle LLC, Red Lodge, Montana, PSC No. 9388, filed an application to increase rates and charges in Passenger Tariff No. 1 of between zero and three hundred thirty-three percent. The rate increase was noticed to the public on April 14, 2000. No protests have been received. Staff recommends approval.

Class B - Persons and baggage (1) between all points and places in Carbon County, Montana; and (2) between all points and places in Carbon County, Montana on the one hand and on the other hand all points and places in the State of Montana.

4. T-00.37.RI (Wayne)

On March 28, 2000 A-1 Ambulance, Inc., Butte, Montana, PSC No. 4261, filed an application to increase rates and charges in Passenger Tariff No. 1 of between fifty and eighty-two percent. The rate increase was noticed

to the public on April 14, 2000. No protests have been received. Staff recommends approval.

SUB A Class B - Nonambulatory wheelchair persons and very occasionally people of ambulatory nature between points and places in Silver Bow, Lewis and Clark, Deer Lodge, Jefferson and Beaverhead Counties, Montana.

5. TN2036 (Wayne)

C.B. Geier, Helena, Montana, requests permission to suspend PSC No. 3584 for six months, April 23, 2000 to October 23, 2000.

SUB E Class C - Property within the City of Helena, Montana and to or from points tributary thereto, but within a distance not exceeding fifty (50) miles thereof. Limitations: Transportation service as an intermediate carrier between two line haul carriers, except pickup and delivery service within the City of Helena, Montana is prohibited. Transportation of ashes, trash, waste, refuse, rubbish and garbage is prohibited.
