**Action Items** All items identified below are for action at the Commission business meeting.

1. TN2063 (Wayne)

Benjamin R. Cohen dba North Valley Refuse, Whitefish, Montana requests permission to continue the lease of PSC No. 3325 to NVR, Inc., dba North Valley Refuse, Whitefish, Montana from September 27, 2000 to September 27, 2001.

Class D - Garbage, waste and refuse (1) within Whitefish, Montana, and points and places within a seven (7) mile radius thereof; and (2) transportation between Whitefish, Montana and the Flathead County line via Highway 93, serving all intermediate points; and (3) transportation movements Nos. 1 and 2 above will terminate at the presently existing sanitary landfill dump nearest Whitefish, Montana.

Limitations: Transportation is prohibited within Columbia Falls, Montana and a five (5) mile radius thereof. Transportation is prohibited within Kalispell, Montana and a ten (10) mile radius thereof.

SUB A Class C & D - Refuse, debris and rubbish from the cleaning out of railroad freight cars and damaged and discarded parts of railroad freight cars and engines but transportation limited to Burlington Northern, Inc., and the Western Fruit Express Company, between points and places in Flathead County, Montana.

2. TN2064 (Wayne)

Montana Tariff Bureau, Agent on behalf of its members Two Shews, Inc. dba Billings Yellow Cab and Mark Foos dba City Cab, request a fuel surcharge be added to Passenger Tariff No. 3. Surcharge is requested in the amount of \$.25 per fare effective July 10, 2000 and expiring on October 8, 2000. This represents a final extension to fuel surcharges previously granted and effective April 11, 2000 to July 10, 2000 and effective July 10, 2000 and expiring on October 10, 2000.

3. TN2065 (Wayne)

Joseph L. Garcia dba Mining City Taxi, Butte, Montana as purchaser/transferee of PSC No. 321, in Docket T-00.40.ST requests that the Commission waive the annual report filing requirements of the owner/transferor Bernard P. Harrington dba City Taxi, Butte, Montana. Annual Reports are due from Mr. Harrington for the calendar year 1999 and that portion of 2000 from January 1 to April 30, 2000. Mr. Harrington is in failing health and is unable or unwilling to complete the reports and Mr. Garcia does not have access to the necessary information.

Class B - Persons, in the City of Butte, Montana and to or from points not exceeding fifty (50) miles of Butte, Montana.

Limitations: Regular or scheduled service as a jitney or bus is prohibited on or over any route.

SUB A Class C - Air freight, between the Butte Airport and points and places within the City of Butte, Montana and an area of ten (10) miles.

On April 26, 2000 Bernard P. Harrington dba City Taxi, Butte, Montana filed an application for transfer of Montana Intrastate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, PSC No. 321, to Joseph L. Garcia dba Mining City Taxi, Butte, Montana.

Class B - Persons, in the City of Butte, Montana and to or from points not exceeding fifty (50) miles of Butte, Montana.  
Limitations: Regular or scheduled service as a jitney or bus is prohibited on or over any route.

SUB A Class C - Air freight, between the Butte Airport and points and places within the City of Butte, Montana and an area of ten (10) miles.

James F. Cole dba Montana Luxury Limo Service, Great Falls, Montana, PSC No. 9426, requests a 90 day extension to the temporary authority granted previously, from September 27, 2000 to December 26, 2000.
