2. T-02.17.ST (Wayne)

On December 28, 2001 Ken Rockeman and Sam Spector, a Partnership dba R & S Personalized Transportation, Big Timber, Montana filed an application for transfer of Montana Intrastate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, PSC No. 9428, to Ken, Matthew & Austin Rockeman and R & S Transportation, Big Timber, Montana. The application for transfer was noticed to the public on February 6, 2002 and no protests were received.

Class B – Passengers in limousine service between all points and places in Gallatin, Park, Stillwater and Sweet Grass County, Montana. LIMITATIONS: 1) All transportation movements must originate or terminate in Sweet Grass County, Montana. 2) Equipment shall be limited to those vehicles listed Paragraph 9 of R & S Transportation’s application or vehicles of similar capacity and utility (four-wheel drive pickups, station wagons or sedans). Transportation in limousine or luxury sedans is prohibited. 3) Transportation through any and all portions of Gallatin and Park Counties shall be ‘closed door’ (no pick-up or deliveries).
