Action Items All items identified below are for action at the Commission business meeting.

1. T-02.100.PCN (Wayne)

On September 9, 2002 David R. Colbrese dba Glendive Taxi, Glendive, Montana applied for a Montana Intrastate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. The application was noticed to the public on October 10, 2002, no protests were received and on November 7, 2002 Final Order 6528 was issued granting the authority. Carrier was advised that prior to issuance of the certificate, compliance consisting of the filing of liability insurance, purchase of vehicle registration receipts and a tariff of rules, rates and charges must be submitted. No compliance was received and an Order to Show Cause was issued on December 30, 2002 and received by the carrier on January 9, 2003. Compliance has not been met.

Class B – Passengers between all points and places within the city of Glendive, Montana and a ten (10) mile radius thereof.

2. TN2166 (Wayne)

Dick Irvin, Inc., Shelby, Montana requests permission to continue the lease of PSC No. 9392 to Irvin, Inc. and Mico, Inc. dba I & T Transfer, Shelby, Montana for a twelve (12) month period, January 6, 2003 to January 6, 2004.

SUB F Class B - Property within the town of Fairfield, Montana, and to or from points tributary thereto, but within a distance not exceeding fifty (50) miles in any direction from said town, and the transportation of building materials only within a distance not exceeding 150 miles in any direction from said town of Fairfield. Limitation: Transportation of ashes, trash, waste, refuse, rubbish and garbage is prohibited.

SUB L Class B - Property in Oilmont, Montana, and in the oil fields tributary thereto, but within a distance not exceeding fifty (50) miles in any direction from said town. Limitations: The transportation of property between points served by rail carriers, or between points served by a motor carrier operating between fixed termini or over a regular route, is prohibited. Transportation of ashes, trash, waste, refuse, rubbish and garbage is prohibited.

SUB M Class B - Property within the City of Conrad, Montana, and to or from points tributary thereto, but within a distance not exceeding fifty (50) miles in any direction from said town. Limitations: The transportation of property between points served by rail carriers, or between points served by a motor carrier operating between fixed termini, or over a regular route, is prohibited. Transportation of ashes, trash, waste, refuse, rubbish and garbage is prohibited.
