**Action Items** All items identified below are for action at the Commission business meeting.

1. T-03.46.PCN (Wayne)

On September 8, 2003, Chad Jay Smith dba Budgit Cab, Great Falls, Montana submitted an application for intrastate operating authority. That application was noticed to the public on October 8, 2003. Protests were received. On December 1, 2003, the applicant requested that the authority be placed on hold and no hearing be scheduled. He was advised that he must contact the Commission by March 1, 2004 and advise that he was prepared to go forward with his application, or his application would be dismissed. There has been no contact from the applicant. Staff recommends that this docket be closed.

Class B - Passengers between all points and places in Great Falls, Montana and a ten (10) mile radius thereof.

On January 21, 2004 Joseph L. Garcia dba Mining City Taxi, Butte, Montana application for a transfer of PSC No. 321 to Mining City Taxi LLC, Butte, Montana. Garcia has requested that this sale and transfer be withdrawn and the docket closed.

Limitations: Regular or scheduled service as a jitney or bus is prohibited on or over any route.

SUB A Class C - Air freight, between the Butte Airport and points and places within the City of Butte, Montana and an area of ten (10) miles.
