On November 19, 2004 Dan R. and Joyce A. Larson dba Larson Disposal and Transport, Seeley Lake, Montana filed a request to transfer PSC No. 1455 to Larson Disposal and Transport LLC, Seeley Lake, Montana. The

sale was noticed to the public on December 6, 2004, a protest was received and later withdrawn.

Class C - Persons, between Missoula, Montana, and Seeley Lake, via Blackfoot route.

SUB A Class D - Garbage and refuse serving Seeley Lake and a ten (10) mile radius in all directions. Carrier is allowed to transport authorized commodities to certified landfills from territory authorized.

SUB B Class D - Garbage and refuse between points and places within five (5) miles of State Highway 283 extending north from the Clearwater Junction (junction of Highway 83 and Montana 200) to the Missoula Lake County Line on the one hand, and to the nearest sanitary landfill dump, certified by the appropriate governmental agency, on the other hand. Limitations: No service is authorized herein from points within a three hundred (300) yard radius of the Clearwater Junction (junction of Highway 83 and Montana 200).
