1. T-06.36.ST (Wayne)

On November 22, 2006 Kenneth W. Griffith dba Ken Griffith Excavating, Baker, Montana filed a request to transfer PSC No. 9452 to G & G Garbage, Inc., Baker, Montana. The transfer request was noticed to the public on December 8, 2006 and no protests were received.

The applicant in this docket, Michael A. Murray II dba Green Taxi, Missoula, Montana, has filed a motion to extend indefinitely, pursuant to 69-12-323(1), the 180 day time period in which the Commission must issue a decision on an application for public convenience necessity. The Commission has statutory discretion to grant such an extension. It requests the extension for discovery purposes on the protestants in the docket and is unsure of the time period required.
