Public Comments

Action Items All items identified below are for action at the Commission business meeting.

1. T-06.31.PCN (Wayne)

On October 23, 2006 Valet Limousine LLC, Missoula, Montana applied for amendments to their authority issued under PSC No. 7172. The

application was noticed to the public and a protest from R & B Limousine Service LLC, PSC No. 9445, was timely filed. However, PSC No. 9445 was transferred from R & B Limousine Service LLC to a new owner on January 18, 2007 and R & B no longer holds any operating authority.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Dismiss the protest of R & B Limousine LLC to Docket T-06.31.PCN due to lack of standing.

2. T-06.31.PCN (Wayne)

On October 23, 2006 Valet Limousine LLC, Missoula, Montana applied for amendments to their authority issued under PSC No. 7172. The application was noticed to the public and the protest from R & B Limousine Service LLC, has been dismissed.

- SUB I Class B - Passengers and personal baggage in limousine service originating from Missoula County Airport to all points and places in Ravalli County. Limitations: Transportation in school buses and motor coaches is prohibited; operations as a taxi or cab is prohibited. Solicitation of train crews for work-related transportation is prohibited. Transportation shall be provided to passengers by reservation only.
- SUB J Class B - Persons and baggage in limousine service between all points and places in Flathead, Lincoln, Missoula, Lake and Glacier Counties. Limitations: The hiring of limousine service must be for the entire vehicle and solicitation of individual passengers to constitute a load is prohibited.
- SUB K Class B - Passengers in limousine service from points in Missoula County to all points and places in Ravalli County.

SUB L Class B - Passengers and personal baggage in limousine service: 1) Between all points and places in the following counties: Ravalli and Cascade; and 2) From all points and places in Ravalli and Cascade Counties to all points and places in Montana and return. Limitations: 1) Operations as a taxi or cab is prohibited. 3) Transportation shall be provided to passengers only by advance reservation of at least two (2) hours. 4) Solicitation of train crews for work-related transportation is prohibited. 5) Service originating in Cascade County may be initiated only at the Great Falls International Airport for the purpose of picking up arriving airplane passengers. 6) Any return movements from points and places outside Ravalli and Cascade are limited to those passengers originating from these counties.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Grant the amendments to PSC No. 7172 as applied for.
