Action Items All items identified below are for action at the Commission business meeting.

1. US WEST Docket N2000.6.83 (LEROY)

On June 14, 2000 US WEST filed Tariff Transmittal 00-20 "Eliminate Toll-PAC" to eliminate the Toll-Pac offering. This special toll offering was route specific for calling between designated exchanges (Alberton to Missoula and Fort Peck to Glasgow). There are currently no customers purchasing this service.

2. US WEST Docket N2000.6.84 (LEROY)

On June 14, 2000 US WEST filed Tariff Transmittal 00-21 "Revisions - Operator Verification Service" to revise the language for operator verification and interrupt to allow charging for these services for data communications in addition to voice. Presently, US West has authority to charge only when voice communication is on the line. Due to the increase of data communications/internet connectivity, US WEST wants the ability to charge for verification of line status when data is on the line. It also provides for the application of charges for verification when it can be determined that the line is in an "off hook" status. There is no change in the rate requested.

3. US WEST Docket N2000.6.85

On June 14, 2000, US WEST filed Tariff Transmittal 00-22, "Promotion Tariff Offering and Promotional Addendum for NONUTILITY Incentive - Access Line". The limited time promotion is scheduled from July 5, 2000, through September 30, 2000, and will be marketed as "Power Strategy 2000". The target market group are small business customers in Montana. Customers who subscribe to an additional Flat Rated Business Line, an additional Centrex 21 line, a CustomChoice Business line, Business Voice Messaging Service will receive a gift certificate of \$25.00 for Business Voice Messaging and \$75.00 for all of the others. Also as part of this promotion, customers who subscribe to ISDN service will receive a \$100.00 rebate on their bill.

4. U S WEST COMMUNICATIONS- Docket N2000.6.87 (S
cott)

On June 15, 2000, U S WEST filed Tariff Transmittal 00-24 to introduce a custom calling feature - Wireless Extension. Wireless Extension allows a customer to integrate their wireline and wireless service. The service is a call forwarding feature that allows the customer to give out one number and be reached either on their wireline or their wireless phone.
