On November 3, 1978, ANSWERING BY BIRKEN (Applicant) filed an application with the Montana Public Service Commission for an Order authorizing the Applicant to increase its installation rates and to decrease its rates for pager services.

Having considered the application and the documentation furnished by Applicant in support of its application and deeming itself fully advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. A notice of proposed public hearing to be held, if requested, was published in the November 28, 1978 edition of the Billings Gazette in Billings, Yellowstone County, Montana. If no requests for a public hearing were received by December 19, 1978 an appropriate order would be issued based upon evidence submitted with the application.

2. No requests for a hearing were received and no hearing was scheduled.

3. Applicant notified the Commission by letter that all of its customers will be informed of the proposed new rates.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The increase applied for is needed to insure continued service to Applicant's customers.
2. The resulting rate levels are reasonable and just.

ORDER

1. The following rates are authorized:

Installation	\$50.00
Pager Service, Tone and Voice per unit	\$24.00




