On December 22, 1978, the Saco Municipal Gas Service (Applicant) filed a petition with the Montana Public Service Commission requesting that the Commission, pursuant to jurisdiction granted by 70-101, et seq., RCM 1947 authorizing Applicant to increase natural gas rates in order to offset the rising costs of labor, production of natural gas, general maintenance, cleaning natural gas wells, and to repair the distribution system.

Having considered the application and the documentation furnished by the Applicant in support of its application and deeming itself fully advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1.) A Notice of Proposed Public Hearing to be held if requested, was published in the January 25, 1979, edition of the Phillips County News and the January 18, 1979, edition of the Glasgow Courier, and the January 18, 1979, edition of the Great Falls Tribune. The Notice stated that if no requests for a public hearing were received by February 13, 1979, an appropriate order would be issued based upon evidence submitted with the application.

2.) No requests for hearing were received and no hearing was scheduled.

3.) The Applicant alleges it needs additional revenue to defray the rising costs of labor, production of natural gas, general maintenance, cleaning natural gas wells, and to repair the distribution system.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1.) The Commission has jurisdiction over parties and proceedings in this matter.

2.) The resulting rate levels are reasonable and just.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:




2.) The approved rates shall be effective for natural gas service rendered on and after March 1, 1979, and other dates as specifically stated in #1 above.

by a 5 - 0 vote.




