This Petition sought to have the date of termination moved from May 1, 1981, to March 1, 1981. This request was denied by the Commission on March 2, 1981.

IT IS ORDERED by the Commission that the application of Martin City Water Co. to terminate service IS GRANTED effective May 1, 1981, subject to the conditions stated in Order No. 4664a by Commissioners Gordon E. Bollinger and Clyde Jarvis dated February 4, 1981.
