IT IS ORDERED by the Commission that the application of the City of Hamilton, Montana is approved as ordered by Commissioner, John Driscoll, in his Proposed Order No. 4868, dated January 6, 1982

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City of Hamilton shall file an Income Statement with this Commission one (1) year after implementation, of these rates so this Commission can review the adequacy of the approved rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a full, true and correct copy of this order be sent forthwith by first class mail to the Applicant herein, and by first class United States mail to

all other appearances herein.

THE FOREGOING ORDER was adopted by the Department of Public Service Regulation of the State of Montana, Public Service Commission, and incorporates Proposed Order No. 4868 by reference.
