ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

On February 3, 1983, Pacific Power & Light Company (PP&L or Company) filed before the Montana Public Service Commission (Commission) a Motion For Reconsideration of Findings Of Fact paragraphs 71 through 78 of Order No. 4928a in Docket No. 82.4.28. These aforementioned paragraphs relate to the Commission's denial of the Company's proposed attrition adjustment.

2.) During its regular agenda meeting on February 14, 1983, the Commission considered PP&L's Motion For Reconsideration.

3.) Therefore, for the reasons stated in Findings of Fact paragraphs 71 through 78 of Order No. 4928a in Docket No. 82.4.28, the Commission hereby DENIES the Company's Motion For Reconsideration concerning an attrition adjustment.
