ORDER OF DISMISSAL

1. On April 30, 1982, Bob McCarthy filed a complaint with the Commission alleging that Mountain Bell had improperly reclassified his telephone account from residential to business based upon his association with Montanan's for Corporate Responsibility, a non-profit political coalition. Mr. McCarthy also alleged that the business deposit required by Mountain Bell at the time of the reclassification was unreasonable.

2. On May 5, 1982, Mountain Bell filed a response to the complaint. As the complaint referenced new stationary wherein Mr. McCarthy's phone number was no longer represented as the sole number for Montanan's for Corporate Responsibility, Mountain Bell concluded that with this change Mr. McCarthy's number could be reclassified as residential and stated its intention to do so as well as returning the business deposit.

3. In light of Mountain Bell's response, Mr. McCarthy filed a written withdrawal of his complaint on May 10, 1982.

NOW THEREFORE, the complaint having been withdrawn, the Commission hereby orders that Docket No. 82.4.24 be DISMISSED.


