On July 1, 1982, The Montana Power Company (Applicant) filed with this Commission a verified Application requesting authority to issue and sell not to exceed 500,000 shares of its no par value common stock to implement its Key Employees' Incentive Stock Ownership Plan. The filing was duly noticed by inclusion thereof in the Utility Agenda of the Commission for July 6, 1982. The Applicant has now indicated that certain additional information not contained in the original application would be helpful to the Commission in its consideration of the Application, has specifically waived its right to disposition of the matter within 30 days of the filing date pursuant to Section 69-3-503, M.C.A., and has requested an Order effectuating a continuance in this Docket for a period of 60 days beyond the statutory period.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Applicant has stated to the Commission that certain information not contained in the original Application in this Docket will be helpful to the Commission in considering the said Application.
2. The applicant has waived its right to disposition of the matter within 30 days of

the filing of the Application₁ that is, 30 days after July 1, 1982.

3. The Applicant has requested the Order issued herein.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The continuance granted in the Order herein is necessary for good cause shown, pursuant to Section 69-3-503, M.C.A.

ORDER

The time for disposition of the Application in Docket No. 82.7.46 is hereby extended for sixth (60) days from and after July 31, 1982.
