FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Shelby Gas Association (Applicant) applied to this Commission for an order authorizing a decrease in the rates Applicant charges for natural gas service. The application sought authority to decrease rates in order to reflect all cost decreases resulting from rate decreases granted The Montana Power Company (Company) in Docket No. 86.4.13.

2. On April 21, 1986, the Commission's Interim Order No. 5197 granted the Company a natural gas rate decrease.

3. On March 14, 1988, the Commission adopted Order No. 5197a that made Interim Order No. 5197 a final order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Shelby Gas Association is a public utility furnishing natural gas to consumers in the State of Montana. As such, it is subject to supervision, regulation and control of the Commission, Section 69-3-101.

2. The Montana Public Service Commission properly exercises jurisdiction over the Applicant's Montana operations pursuant to Title 69, Chapter 3, MCA.

ORDER

1. Rates approved on an interim basis are hereby made permanent.
