FINDINGS OF FACT

On June 12, 1986, Yellowstone Pipe Line Company (Applicant) filed an application with the Montana Public Service Commission, pursuant to Section 69-13-3-201 (1), MCA., to establish a new tariff, Montana P.S.C. No. 26, in conjunction with Continental Pipe Line Company to move diesel fuel from Billings to Laurel for the Burlington Northern Railroad (BN).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Montana Public Service Commission properly exercises jurisdiction over the Applicant's Montana operations pursuant to Section 69-13-201(1), MCA.
2. Section 69-2-304, MCA, provides in part, "The Commission may, in its discretion, temporarily approve increases or decreases pending a hearing or final decision.

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Yellowstone Pipe Line Company's Montana P.S.C. No. 26 tariff is hereby approved on an interim basis.

2. A Notice Of Opportunity For Public Hearing will be issued pursuant to Section 69-13-201(2), MCA.
