ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

On January 9, 1987 the Montana Public Service Commission noticed the complaint of Dennis Burkhardtmeier against Montana Power Company (MPC). The complaint generally alleged that MPC had wrongly billed Autotek, Inc. for power to 2244 Grand Avenue, Billings, Montana, after notification and agreement that MPC would shut off the power and correct the billing.

On February 10, 1987 the Commission granted MPC an extension of time to file its answer or satisfy the complaint.

On February 10, 1987 Mr. Burkhardtmeier wrote the Commission that his complaint was resolved to his satisfaction with a mutual agreement to pay and accept \$363.65 for payment of service.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Montana Public Service Commission has jurisdiction over complaints against public utilities, pursuant to < 69-3-321, MCA.

A person may make a complaint against a utility subject to Commission jurisdiction pursuant to the rules ARM 38.2.2101 et seq. A copy of such complaints shall be noticed and served upon the defendant. ARM 38.2.2104.

Upon acceptance of a statement of satisfaction of complaint, no further proceeding need be taken. ARM 38.2.2106.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, The Complaint in this Docket is dismissed and the matter closed.
