ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

The Salish-Kootenai College (SKC) filed a complaint on October 25, 1990 concerning provisioning of foreign exchange service from the Polson exchange to Pablo, Montana by Ronan Telephone Company (RTC). The relief requested was an order from the Montana Public Service Commission (Commission) requiring RTC to provide the service according to the rates designated in its tariff.

In June, 1993, SKC indicated by letter to the Commission that it had reached an agreement for the service with RTC and requested to withdraw the complaint without prejudice. Closing the complaint was deferred pending receipt of a copy of the agreement between RTC and SKC. SKC subsequently acquired the service from another provider.

The Montana Public Service Commission has concluded its work in this docket, the complaint having been satisfied. Therefore, it

is Ordered that this docket is closed and may be deleted from case management.
