FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On December 6, 1990, the Montana Power Company (MPC) filed its annual gas tracking application, which was denominated Docket No. 90.12.84. MPC seeks approval of deferred gas costs, as well as a gas cost for purposes of computing the base cost of gas for the ensuing period. It also seeks to recover balances which have accrued because of the difference between sales made at the Interruptible Market Retention (IMR) rate and interruptible industrial gas rate.

2. A Notice of Opportunity for Public Hearing was issued and no protests nor requests for hearing were received.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Applicant is a "public utility" within the meaning of Section 69-3-101, MCA.

2. The Montana Public Service Commission properly exercises jurisdiction over the Applicant's Montana operations pursuant to Title 69, Chapter 3, MCA.

ORDER

1. Rates approved on an interim basis are hereby made permanent.
