Order on Reconsideration

During September of 1992, the Commission received three petitions for the allocation of N11 dialing codes. The three petitioners later merged into one company called Infodial, Inc. On September 29, the Commission opened a Notice of Inquiry (NOI) concerning the N11 filings. In response to the NOI, comments and reply comments were submitted to the Commission by Infodial and various other parties.

After consideration of the comments received in response to the NOI, the Commission issued Order 5682, which denied Infodial's petition for the allocation of an N11 dialing code. On January 14, 1993, Infodial filed a Motion for Reconsideration of Order No. 5682.

A procedure was implemented which allowed interested parties to file comments on Infodial's Motion, and allowed Infodial to file reply comments.

At a duly noticed work session on August 24, 1993, the Commission denied Infodial's Motion for Reconsideration of Order No. 5682. The Commission determined that due to the scarcity of N11 codes, the potential public service applications of the codes, and the uncertainty regarding possible Federal Communications Commission action in FCC Docket No. 92-105, N11 code assignment to INFODIAL would be inappropriate at this time.

This docket is hereby closed.
