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ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER OF ASSETS AND LIABILITIES

On May 25, 2001, LaCasa Grande Estates Water Company, filed an application before the Public Service Commission (PSC), requesting approval of a transfer of its public utility assets and liabilities to LaCasa Grande Water and Sewer District. LaCasa Grande Estates Water Company is the owner of public utility water distribution system providing water service to the LaCasa Grande Estates Subdivision in Lewis and Clark County.

On June 1, 2001, the PSC publicly noticed LaCasa Grande Estates Water Company's application, public comments or requests for hearing were to be submitted no later than June 21, 2001. No person has requested a hearing or submitted comments.

The PSC determines that the proposed transfer should be approved. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the transfer of the public utility assets and liabilities of LaCasa Grande Estates Water Company to the LaCasa Grande Water and Sewer District is approved.
