Background

On July 21, 2000, the FCC issued its "Second Report and Order," in *NIINPRM* (FCC 00-257)(N11 order), requiring the nationwide implementation of access to Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS) via the abbreviated dialing code 711. The FCC requires this implementation to be completed by October 1, 2001.

On July 26, 2001, Qwest Communication made a filing with the Montana Public Service Commission in Tariff Transmittal 01-21 "711 Services Deployment".

Order

Qwest is directed to implement 711 within five business days from the date of this order in order to begin testing prior to the implementation date of October 1, 2001.
