DEFAULT ORDER

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On July 21, 2005, the Montana Public Service Commission (PSC) received an application from Cenex Pipeline LLC (Cenex) for authority to increase rates and charges to shippers on its Laurel to Billings, Laurel to Glendive and Billings to Glendive, Montana petroleum products pipeline. The total requested increase of 3.6 percent is based on the Oil Pipeline Index as published by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). This methodology allows oil pipelines to change rates through the use of an index system that has established ceiling levels for such rates. Cenex has filed a new tariff (Montana PSC No. 23).
2. On July 26, 2005, the PSC issued a Notice of Application and Intervention Deadline with requests for intervention due no later than August 16, 2005.
3. No request for intervention has been received.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Montana Public Service Commission has jurisdiction over the rates and charges of common carrier pipelines pursuant to Title 69, Chapter 13, Montana Code Annotated (MCA).

2. Cenex Pipeline LLC is a common carrier pipeline transporting petroleum products and therefore is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The PSC approves the increase for rates and charges on this pipeline
2. This Order shall be effective for service rendered on and after October 1, 2005.
