MCC-018 Regarding: Farm Tap/Former HPC Employee
 Witness: Marc T. Mallowney

At MTM-6, Mr. Mallowney discusses a former HPC employee who has been a farm tap customer since 1996.

- a. Please provide a copy of any maps in the possession of HPC or NorthWestern that show the location of this farm tap customer and the HPC gathering and/or transmission pipeline used to serve this farm tap customer.
- b. Please describe the facilities that were used by HPC to connect and initiate gas delivery service to this farm tap customer.
- c. Please state the actual or estimated cost that was incurred by HPC to connect and initiate gas delivery service to this farm tap customer.

RESPONSE:

- a. The location of the farm tap discussed on page MTM-6 is shown on page 38 of the booklet provided in response to Data Request MCC-017. The farm tap is located in the SE corner of Section 33, Township 34N, R 19E.
- b. The farm tap in question was installed at a location where there was already an existing tap on the transmission line serving another customer (#990001). This customer completed a rural farm tap application in 1975.

The former HPC employee's service was added in 1996 and was piped from the existing customer's service line. Since the gas was already regulated, only metering was added for the two customers. HPC supplied the two meters only; any other costs would have been covered by the former employee.

- c. The actual costs for the installation for the former employee are unknown. However, it is believed that HPC only installed two meters. These meters today cost \$85 each. Adding the labor that was required to drive to the location and install them, HPC estimates that the total cost incurred by HPC was about \$430.
