NOTICE OF COMMISSION ACTION
ON PRO HAC VICE APPEARANCE

On August 6, 2015, the State Bar of Montana (State Bar) forwarded to the Montana Public Service Commission (Commission) the completed Application of David Wooley of Keyes, Fox & Wiedman to appear *pro hac vice* in Docket D2015.6.51. According to the State Bar, Mr. Wooley “has complied with the rules governing a *pro hac vice* appearance and is currently in good standing with the other state[s]... in which [he] is admitted.” Ltr. p. 1 (Aug. 6, 2015).

Section IV(c) of the Rules for Admission to the State Bar provides: “Except upon a showing of good cause, no attorney or firm may appear *pro hac vice* in more than two actions or proceedings in any state court or administrative agency in Montana.” The State Bar informed the Commission that this would be the first *pro hac vice* appearance for Mr. Wooley and the first appearance for the firm.

On August 18, 2015, the Commission approved the Application and accepted Mr. Wooley’s appearance *pro hac vice* in Docket D2015.6.51.
