NorthWestern Energy's Petition for Intervention

On August 17, 2015, Greycliff Wind Prime, LLC ("Greycliff") filed a *Petition to Have Commission Set Contract Terms and Conditions Pursuant to M.C.A. § 69-3-603* ("Petition") with the Montana Public Service Commission ("Commission"). In its Petition, Greycliff asserts that it has been unable to reach a mutually acceptable agreement with NorthWestern Energy ("NorthWestern") for the sale of energy produced by it to NorthWestern. Greycliff further asserts that it is a qualifying facility ("QF") that has established a legally enforceable obligation ("LEO") and requests the Commission establish a contract between Greycliff and NorthWestern

which includes a rate of \$53.85 per megawatt hour (“MWh”) (or an effective rate of \$50.35/MWh if wind integration is excluded from the rate).

On August 20, 2015, the Commission issued a Notice of Petition and Intervention Deadline establishing September 3, 2015 as the date any interested person who is directly affected by the Petition must file a petition for intervention. NorthWestern requests general intervention in this matter.

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
