
**JOINT REQUEST OF GREYCLIFF WIND PRIME, LLC AND NORTHWESTERN
ENERGY FOR TWO ADDITIONAL WEEKS TO CONCLUDE NEGOTIATIONS**

Petitioner Greycliff Wind Prime, LLC (hereinafter "Greycliff"), and NorthWestern Energy ("NorthWestern") each acting by and through their respective counsel, respectfully request that the Montana Public Service Commission ("Commission") grant Greycliff and NorthWestern two additional weeks until February 29, 2016 to conduct and conclude negotiations in this matter. The negotiation period set forth in prior Commission orders is

scheduled to expire on February 15, 2016. During the pendency of the negotiation period, both Greycliff and NorthWestern have participated in good faith attempting to resolve the outstanding contract issues in this case. To date, despite numerous calls, Greycliff and NorthWestern agree that negotiations have not resulted in resolution of this matter. During a call scheduled for February 8 to discuss this matter further, Greycliff advised NorthWestern that additional people working with Greycliff needed to review NorthWestern's proposed revisions to the contract. The parties believe that two additional weeks will assist them in negotiations and allow for the narrowing of any issues that the Commission might ultimately need to resolve should negotiations between the parties prove unsuccessful. Consequently, Greycliff and NorthWestern jointly request that the Commission grant an extension of the negotiation period until and including February 29, 2016.


