ERRATUM

On December 22, 1997, the Montana Public Service Commission (Commission) designated RT Communications, Inc., a Wyoming incumbent local exchange carrier serving some subscribers located in Montana, as an "eligible telecommunications carrier" (ETC) for

purposes of federal universal service support for the Montana portion of its Hulett, Wyoming exchange. After issuing Order No. 6005b, the Commission discovered a typographical error repeated several times in its order. Throughout Order No. 6005b, the Commission incorrectly used the business name "RC Communications, Inc." instead of "RT Communications, Inc." To correct those errors, the Commission issues the attached revised Order No. 6005b to substitute for the original which was issued on December 24, 1997.
