On December 31, 1997, Black Hills Corporation d/b/a Black Hills Power and Light Company (BHP&L or Applicant) filed a petition with the Montana Public Service Commission pursuant to §§ 69-3-101 et seq., MCA, for an order authorizing the Applicant to decrease its electric rates in order to reflect the decreased cost of fuel used in the generation of electricity. The fuel costs concerned are for the months of September, October and November 1997.

On January 6, 1998, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity For Public Hearing. A provision in that notice stated, "If, however, no hearing is requested by January 26, 1998, the Commission will consider the matter and a default order may be issued."

Having considered the application and the documentation furnished by the Applicant in support of its application and deeming itself fully advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. If decreased fuel costs for the months of September, October and November, 1997, are to be recovered, a charge of \$.00126 must be subtracted from the base fuel cost of \$.01240 approved in Docket No. 83.4.25, which

results in a total fuel charge of \$.01114 per Kwh. The Quarterly Fuel Rate Rider will decrease revenues by approximately \$3,213 below fuel costs authorized in Docket No. 83.4.25.

2. The number of customers presently being served in Montana is 47.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Commission has jurisdiction over parties and proceeding in this matter.
2. The resulting rate levels are reasonable and just.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Quarterly Fuel Rate Rider for the billing period of February, March and April 1998 is \$.00126 per Kwh. This charge shall be subtracted from the base fuel cost approved in Docket No. 83.4.25.
2. The approved rates shall be effective for electric service rendered on and after February 1, 1998.
