ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

The Montana Public Service Commission has confirmed that Montana Tel-Net has ceased doing business as a reseller of local exchange service in Montana. All of Montana Tel-Net's customers in Montana have been notified that they must select a new local exchange carrier before September 1, 1998, in order to continue service. The Commission concludes that Montana Tel-Net's application for designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier for purposes of receiving universal service support needs no further consideration.

THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the above docket is closed and may be deleted from case management.
