FINAL ORDER

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Shelby Gas Company (Applicant) applied to this Commission for an order authorizing an increase in the rates Applicant charges for natural gas service. The application sought authority to increase rates in order to reflect all cost increases resulting from Montana Power Company's (MPC) Docket No. D99.11.247.
2. On December 9, 1999, the Commission Order No. 6212 granted MPC an interim natural gas rate increase.
3. Order No. 6212 resulted in higher purchased gas costs to Applicant.
4. Order No. 6212c made the interim natural gas rate increase permanent.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Applicant is a "public utility" within the meaning of Section 69-3-101, MCA.
2. The Montana Public Service Commission properly exercises jurisdiction over the Applicant's Montana operations pursuant to Title 69, Chapter 3, MCA.

ORDER

1. Applicant is hereby granted relief reflecting Findings of Fact in this order.
2. Such relief is to become effective for services rendered on and after December 10, 1999, and remain in effect until such time as this order is superceded.
3. The rates shall be collected upon a constant uniform cents per Mcf basis.
