ORDER CONDITIONALLY APPROVING TARIFFS

On November 20, 1998, One Eighty Communications, Inc. (One Eighty), filed before the Public Service Commission (PSC) a price list setting forth One Eighty's service offerings, rates, terms, and conditions for intrastate telecommunications service in Montana. The PSC has reviewed One Eighty's filing and determines that it should be approved on condition.

The PSC is presently considering existing PSC telecommunications regulations, which were designed prior to the now-developing competitive telecommunications environment, to determine which of these regulations are applicable or should be made applicable to competitive local exchange carriers such as One Eighty. The PSC is also considering whether additional rules (i.e., new rules) should be adopted for regulation of competitive local exchange carriers. It is anticipated that PSC decisions in regard to existing rules and new rules may affect One Eighty's approved tariffs. One Eighty must file to amend its approved tariffs within a reasonable time, not to exceed 30 days, of notice regarding any PSC final decision on the application of PSC existing rules or adoption of new rules pertaining to competitive local exchange carriers.
