ANNUAL REPORT GENERIC PROTECTIVE ORDER


On July 8, 2002, Clark Fork Telecommunications, Inc. (CFT), filed before the Public Service Commission (PSC) a request for protective order governing access to CFT's PSC annual report schedules 23 (central office and access line statistics) and 24 (central office and switch information). CFT argues the information is trade secret (is maintained as secret and has economic value in being so maintained) and subject to protection from uncontrolled disclosure. On July 26, 2002, the PSC issued a public notice of CFT's request. No comments or objections were received.


The PSC determines that the identified information, except schedule column totals reported to the Federal Communications Commission, if any, could be confidential and subject to protection from public disclosure pursuant to § 69-3-105, MCA. Therefore, the PSC grants CFT's request and hereby orders that information submitted in accordance with this order be treated as "confidential information" under the terms of this order and PSC protective order rules, ARM 38.2.5001 through 38.2.5030. This generic annual report protective order is effective for a period of 4 years, at which time CFT may apply for an extension.


