NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF PUBLIC MEETING

On September 24, 2015, the Montana Public Service Commission (PSC) issued a *Notice of Inquiry and Opportunity to Comment* concerning its implementation of the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 (PURPA), which requires electric utilities to purchase energy and capacity made available from qualifying facilities (QFs). 18 C.F.R. § 292.303(a) (2015); Mont. Code Ann. § 69-8-602 (2015). The PSC received comments from numerous entities, and on December 2, 2015, requested additional comments addressing the symmetrical treatment of QF and utility-owned resources.

On March 1, 2016, the PSC issued a *Notice of Public Meeting* scheduling a public meeting in this matter on Tuesday, May 3, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. (or immediately following its weekly business meeting) in the PSC's Bollinger Room, 1701 Prospect Avenue, Helena, Montana 59601. Due to other business before the Commission, the public meeting on Tuesday, May 3, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. is hereby **CANCELLED**. The public meeting will be reset for a future date.
