ORDER ON MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

On November 28, 1988 the Public Service Commission issued Final Order No. 5893 in the above matter, cancelling the Intrastate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, PSC No. 2818, owned and operated by Christofferson Logliners, Inc., for failure to file an annual report.

On January 8, 1990 Christofferson Logliners, Inc., filed a Motion to Waive Ten Day Rule, a Motion to Reconsider and an Affidavit in Support of Motion for Reconsideration.

The basis upon which the motions are made, as determined from the motions and supporting affidavit, is that Christofferson Logliners, Inc., had engaged an accounting firm as agent to perform certain duties, including the filing of annual reports. Through misfeasance or malfeasance the annual reports were not filed.

Good and sufficient cause appearing, therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the motions are granted, Order No. 5893 in Docket No. T-16821, Service Date: November 28, 1988, is vacated, and the Intrastate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, PSC No. 2818, owned and operated by Christofferson Logliners, Inc., is reinstated.
