The Commission, having taken evidence and being fully advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On September 4, 1985, City Taxi, Inc., P.O. Box 3041, Bozeman Montana 59715, filed an application with the Montana Public Service Commission under Title 69, MCA, to amend Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PSC 2278, Sub A, to remove the limitation underscored below:

CLASS B - persons in the City of Bozeman, Montana and points tributary thereto, but not exceeding a distance of 50 miles therefrom. LIMITATIONS: Regular or scheduled service as a jitney or bus is prohibited on or over any route, providing however, that such limitation does not prohibit the transportation of persons in regular service in a jitney or bus (a) within Bozeman, Montana; and (b) between Bozeman, Montana and the Gallatin Airfield, Belgrade, Montana.

2. In accordance with Section 69-23-321, MCA, as amended, this matter was noticed to the public October 4, 1985. That notice said in pertinent part:

If no written protests are received by October 24, 1985, a hearing may not be held and a final order may be issued in this Docket. If a protest is received, a hearing will be scheduled. Individual notice of the hearing will be given only to Protestants and Applicant.

The application included affidavits of support.

3. No protests or responses of any kind were received.

4. The record of this application is available for inspection at the

Public Service Commission Office, 2701 Prospect Avenue, Helena, Montana 59620.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Montana Public Service Commission properly exercises jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter in this proceeding.
2. The Commission afforded all parties interested in this proceeding proper notice and an opportunity to participate.
3. Public Convenience and Necessity require a grant of the authority sought by the Applicant.

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, at a session of the Public Service Commission, Department of Public Service Regulation of the State of Montana, held in its offices at 2701 Prospect Avenue, Helena, Montana, on the 12th day of November 1985, there being present a quorum of Commissioners, there came regularly before the Commission for final action the matters and things in Docket No. T-8809, and the Commission being fully advised in the premises;

IT IS ORDERED by the Commission that the application of City Taxi, Inc., Bozeman, Montana to amend Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PSC 2278 Sub A to remove the limitations IS GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that PSC 2278 Sub A be returned to this office for reissuance to remove the limitations.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a full, true and correct copy of this order be sent forthwith by certified mail to the Applicant herein.

THE FOREGOING ORDER was adopted by the Department of Public Service Regulation of the State of Montana, Public Service Commission, IN OPEN SESSION at Helena, Montana, this 12th of November, 1985 by a vote of 5-0.
