The Commission, having taken evidence and being fully advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On September 23, 1993, Roland and Lisa Morris dba Mission Valley Medicab, 10207 Wheatland Road, Moiese, Montana 59824 filed an application with the Montana Public Service Commission under Title 69, MCA, for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing transportation of the following:

2. In accordance with Section 69-23-321, MCA, as amended, this matter was noticed to the public October 7, 1993. That notice said in pertinent part:

If no written protests are received by 27, a hearing may not be held and a final order may be issued in this Docket. If a protest is received, a hearing will be scheduled. Individual notice of the hearing will be given only to Protestants and Applicant.

The application included affidavits of support.

3. A protest was filed by Beach Transportation Co., Missoula, Montana. That protest was subsequently withdrawn. No other protests or responses of any kind were received.

4. The record of this application is available for inspection at the Public Service Commission Office, 1701 Prospect Avenue, P.O. Box 202601, Helena, Montana 59620-2601.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Montana Public Service Commission properly exercises jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter in this proceeding.

2. The Commission afforded all parties interested in this proceeding proper notice and an opportunity to participate.

3. Public Convenience and Necessity require a grant of the authority sought by the Applicant.

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, at a session of the Public Service Commission, Department of Public Service Regulation of the State of Montana, held in its offices at 1701 Prospect Avenue, Helena, Montana, on the 22nd day of November, 1993, there being present a quorum of Commissioners, there came regularly before the Commission for final action the matters and things in Docket

No. T-93.135.PCN, and the Commission being fully advised in the premises;

IT IS ORDERED by the Commission that the application of ROLAND AND LISA MORRIS DBA MISSION VALLEY MEDICAB, Moiese, Montana, for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity IS GRANTED to the following extent:

Class B - Non-emergency medical and psychiatric patients from Ravalli, Missoula, Lake and Sanders Counties to medical appointments at health care facilities in Ravalli, Missoula, Flathead, Lake and Sanders Counties and return.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Montana Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, PSC 9199, issued July 31, 1992 be returned to the Commission offices for cancellation in lieu of the expanded authority granted herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a full, true and correct copy of this order be sent forthwith by first class mail to the applicant and all parties herein.

THE FOREGOING ORDER was adopted by the Department of Public Service Regulation of the State of Montana, Public Service Commission, IN OPEN SESSION at Helena, Montana, this 22nd day of November, 1993, by a vote of 5 - 0.
