The Commission, having taken evidence and being fully advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On March 28, 1994, the City of Wolf Point, 201 Fourth Avenue South, Wolf Point, MT 59201-1592 filed an application with the Montana Public Service Commission under Title 69, MCA, for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing transportation of the following:

Class D - Solid waste within a six mile radius of the City of Wolf Point, Montana.

2. In accordance with Section 69-23-321, MCA, as amended, this matter was noticed to the public April 6, 1994. That notice said in pertinent part:

If no written protests are received by April 26, 1994, a hearing may not be held and a final order may be issued in this Docket. If a protest is received, a hearing will be scheduled. Individual notice of the hearing will be given only to Protestants and Applicant.

The application included affidavits of support.

3. No protest or request for hearing was received.

4. The record of this application is available for inspection at the Public Service Commission Office, 1701 Prospect Avenue, P.O. Box 202601, Helena, Montana 59620-2601.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Montana Public Service Commission properly exercises jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter in this proceeding.

2. The Commission afforded all parties interested in this proceeding proper notice and an opportunity to participate.

3. Public Convenience and Necessity require a grant of the authority sought by the Applicant.

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, at a session of the Public Service Commission, Department of Public Service Regulation of the State of Montana, held in its offices at 1701 Prospect Avenue, Helena, Montana, on the 24th day of May, 1994, there being present a quorum of Commissioners, there came regularly before the Commission for final action the matters and things in Docket No. T-94.26.PCN, and the Commission being fully advised in the premises;

IT IS ORDERED by the Commission that the application of **City of Wolf Point**, Wolf Point, Montana, for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity IS GRANTED to the following extent:

Class D - Solid waste between points located within six miles of the 1994 exterior boundaries of the City of Wolf Point. Carrier is authorized to transport to certified landfills from territory authorized.

IT IS ORDERED that the City of Wolf Point submit to the Commission a map or diagram detailing the 1994 boundaries of the city.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a full, true and correct copy of this order be sent forthwith by first class mail to the applicant and all parties herein.

THE FOREGOING ORDER was adopted by the Department of Public Service Regulation of the State of Montana, Public Service Commission, IN OPEN SESSION at Helena, Montana, this 24th day of May, 1994, by a vote of 5 - 0.
