The Commission, being fully advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On March 28, 1995, Carol T. Place dba Tour de Great Falls, P.O. Box 27, Ulm, MT 59485-0027 filed an application with the Montana Public Service Commission under Title 69, MCA, for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing transportation of the following:

Class B - Passengers within the city of Great Falls, Montana and a twenty-five (25) mile radius thereof.

2. In accordance with Section 69-23-321, MCA, this matter was noticed to the public April 5, 1995. That notice said in pertinent part:

If no written protests are received by April 25, 1995, a hearing may not be held and a final order may be issued in this Docket. If a protest is received, a hearing will be scheduled. Individual notice of the hearing will be given only to Protestants and Applicant.

The application included affidavits of support.

3. Protests were filed by Hall Transit Charter Service, Inc., Great Falls, Montana; and Great Falls Capital Corporation, Great Falls, Montana.



THE FOREGOING ORDER was adopted by the Department of Public Service Regulation of the State of Montana, Public Service Commission, IN OPEN SESSION at Helena, Montana, this 5th day of June, 1995, by a vote of 5 - 0.
