VACATING ORDER

The protests having been withdrawn based on the following stipulation agreed to by all parties, the proposed rates being just and reasonable:

Stipulation: If the proposed increase is granted both Billings Yellow Cab and City Cab will implement a pay incentive program whereby new drivers are paid \$5.25 an hour. After 360 hours of successful performance hourly pay will increase to \$5.60 per hour. Upon the completion of 1080 hours of successful performance drivers will be paid \$ 6.00 per hour.

This stipulation is considered the minimum pay for drivers and does not limit a driver to a maximum of \$6.00 per hour if the companies deem additional pay is warranted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Suspension is VACATED, rates to be effective upon the filing of new tariff pages correctly setting forth the proposed rates.
