We are asking you to reject Bull Mountain's request to haul in all the rural areas of Musselshell County without a PSC Class D Permit. This could affect all Class D haulers and not just in Musselshell County.

We have been hauling our customers' garbage for 21 years. We employ 2 local people in our company and provide benefits. These are good jobs within our communities.

We are concerned about ALL customers. A Class D permit is a privilege and we respect our obligation to provide service to all customers within our area. This is important to people in rural areas. It is not always easy or convenient as some may live in areas difficult to get to, over poor roads and weather conditions can make it even more difficult, not to mention some customers are elderly and have NO means to haul their own garbage.


